Create a timeline of the Victorian era. Choose a particular event from the line to research and present to the class in a creative way.								
Write a story/diary about being a Victorian child working in a mill, down the mines or as a sweep's boy/girl								
Double Points!	Plan a Victorian-style banquet for you and your friends. Include invitations and recipes and calculate how much it would cost.							
	For 10 extra points, choose an item to cook and try it out on your own family. Interview them to find out what they thought!							
Design outfits for rich and poor Victorians. Describe what they would wear and what materials their clothes would be made from. How are these materials different from today.								
Create a portrait of a famous Victorian. Find out about what made them famous and present this information to the class								
Write a newspaper report about an event that happened during the Victorian times. Remember the 5 w's (<i>what, when, where, why, who</i>) and include pictures								
Find out how Victorians celebrated Christmas. What did they do that we still do now?								
Plan a Christmas meal for your family using locally sourced food (most food was local in Victorian times!) Find out how much it would cost for the whole meal and the cost per person.								
Design and make a Victorian-style Christmas Card. Use a Victorian style font to write your message.								
Investigate Victorian inventions. Draw and write about an invention which we still use today (even if it's been updated now). How does it have an impact on our lives?								
Learn your tables up to 10x10 and associated division facts.
